

Cookie policy

Ninatrans NV uses cookies to make your online experience easier and more pleasant. This also serves to better match the content of its websites with your needs and preferences. You can refuse the installation of cookies, but in that case certain parts of our sites will not function or their use will be sub-optimal. As long as you continue browsing without changing your cookie settings (and in clicking on the "**Accept Cookies**" link) we will consider that you accept the installation of cookies.

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small text file which is stored by a website server in the browser of your computer or mobile device when you visit the website. The cookie contains a unique code that allows your browser to recognize your browser when you visit the website (called a "session cookie") or on future repeat visits (called a "persistent cookie"). Cookies can be placed by the server of the website you visit or by partners with whom this website collaborates. The server of a website can only read the cookies which it has placed itself. It does not have access to any information on your computer or mobile device. Cookies are stored on your computer or mobile device in your browser directory. The contents of a cookie generally consist of the name of the server which placed the cookie, an expiry date and a unique encrypted code.

Cookies generally ensure an easier and faster interaction between the visitor and the website. They help the visitor to navigate between different parts of the website. Cookies may also be used to make the content of a website more relevant. The same applies to advertising on a website. This also makes it possible to adapt them to the preferences and needs of the visitor.

Cookie management

You may refuse the installation of cookies through your browser settings. On this [page](#), you will find how to refuse cookies in the most commonly used browsers. You can also delete cookies already installed on your computer or mobile device at any time.
